Applications

- Applications are subject to District Supervisor approval.
- Check with the District Office for any conflicts with reserved dates as hunting will be restricted to only one hunting party per day. The event date will not be reserved until the application has received District Supervisor approval. Permits will be available from January 1 to March 31. (Sundays excluded).

Permit Conditions

- Each member of the hunting party shall possess on their person, a copy of this permit while hunting.
- This permit allows the applicant(s) to purchase, liberate and hunt ring-neck pheasant and/or bobwhite quail on the above specified area on the date valid.
- Birds that are purchased in state must be purchased from a licensed game bird propagator in Massachusetts. **An importation permit must be obtained from the DFW Boston office (617) 626-1590 for purchasing and importing game birds from out of state.**
- This permit allows for the possession of live ring-necked pheasants and/or bobwhite quail for 1-day prior to the valid permit date.
- Only hunters possessing a valid Special Winter Gamebird Stocking Permit are allowed to liberate and hunt ring-necked pheasants or bobwhite quail on said area. **This permit does not exclude other users from utilizing the above named area for other purposes.**
- A valid Special Winter Gamebird Stocking Permit incorporates a liberation permit for the date and place specified in the permit.
- Members in the hunting party must wear a hunter orange cap.
- Vehicles are prohibited on the Wildlife Management Area for stocking or hunting purposes unless field conditions are suitable and prior arrangements have been made with the District Supervisor.
